These Guidelines apply to the donation and preparation of materials derived from blood, tissue and stem cells by the United Kingdom Blood Transfusion and Tissue Transplantation Services for therapeutic and diagnostic use. The guidelines reflect an expert view of current best practice, provide specifications for products and components, and describe technical details of processes. Every effort has been made to ensure that the guidelines reflect the legally binding requirements of the *Blood Safety (and Quality) and Regulations, UK Statutory Instrument 2005*.

Since the last hard-copy publication of the Guidelines (known as the Red Book) in 2013, there have been many updates and the usefulness of hard copy documents has declined. Therefore, the Guidelines will now be published online only.

Publication of Guidelines and any subsequent updates does not necessarily mean that the practices outlined are brought into use by all services, or that implementation will be simultaneous - the implementation dates may be decided separately by the four 4 Services.
